

Billy and the #86 team arrived at Flamboro Speedway on Saturday for a regular night of racing as they kick off their first full season since 2019. The team switched a couple of crew members around for the day as car owner and crew chief Ken put another hat on to spot for Billy as Billy's regular spotter David would continue to spot for the #44 of Steve Laking as he had for the previous two weekends.





Billy showed speed early on as he went to the top of the board during

the first of two practice sessions for the day with only some minor adjustments being required as the team readied for the first of two 25-lap features. With the invert, Billy lined up on the outside pole for the second feature of the night and quickly



took advantage as he took the lead early on lap 1. As the field started to string out Billy jumped out to a sizeable lead and did not look back picking up his first win of the season.



With Billy and the #86 team at Flamboro, Cole and the #18 returned to Sunset Speedway for the \$1,000 to win Open Invitational where the mini stock class was supporting the NASCAR Pinty's Series. Race day at Sunset kicked off with two practice sessions in the early part of the day with Cole feeling confident and comfortable with the adjustments made to the car. Lining up on the outside of the second row in 4<sup>th</sup> for the first heat race, Cole got up to 2<sup>nd</sup> early on and while trying to make the pass into the lead, the #18

broke loose resulting in Cole dropping back to the 3<sup>rd</sup> position where he would finish. Starting deep in the field for the second heat race, Cole was able to make his way forward to finish 4<sup>th</sup>.

Cole lined up in the 7<sup>th</sup> position for the 30-lap feature and spent much of the first half of the race trying to get up through the field as he moved up into 6<sup>th</sup> by lap 6 and then into the top-5 on lap 11. The #18 started to pull away from the rest of the field behind him as he started to chase down the leaders. Late in the race he was able to make one more pass to finish in 4<sup>th</sup> to bring home his third consecutive top-5 finish at Sunset to start off the season.



Billy and the #86 team head north on Saturday May 21<sup>st</sup> as the APC United Late Model Series weekend kicks off at Sunset Speedway as part of Spring Velocity with the Dayco 100. The front gates open at 3:30PM with racing getting underway at 5:00PM. Cole and the #18 team hope to build off their top-5 finish this past weekend as they return to Sunset on Sunday May 22<sup>nd</sup> for a 35-lap mini stock invitational as part of Spring Velocity. The front gates open at 12:30PM with racing getting underway at 2:00PM.
