



There wasn't a cloud in the sky as Billy and the #86 team headed down Highway 6 to Flamboro Speedway to try and maintain their points lead over the #27 of Kevin Albers and the #55 of Chris Howse.

The #86 was quickest during the first practice session of the day so the team used the second session to scuff a set of left side tires that were going to be used at a later date.

Having won the second feature the previous weekend, Billy lined up back in

the 4th position for the first of twin 25-lap features. The front of the field quickly started to pull away at the drop of the green flag as Billy battled with the #21 of Logan White for the 3rd position. The team had an older set of tires on the car for the first feature and it showed as well as Billy struggled to keep the #86 underneath him as the laps ticked by. Quickly realizing that he did not have a winning car, Billy settled into the 4th position and didn't try to push the envelope too hard as the #55 picked up the win. In between features the team went to work putting on new right-side tires which should have helped with the tire stagger and the team also went to work on bleeding the brakes.



Billy lined up on the outside of the #12 of Roland Goodfellow for the second feature of the night and had to ease into the gas on the initial start to avoid jumping ahead of the #12. As the field took the green flag, the #86 pulled out front and quickly passed the #12 on the outside coming out of turn 2 to take the lead. That was all she wrote as Billy led flag to flag to bring home his fourth feature win of the season. By leading the most laps and picking up the win, Billy was able to make up the points that he had lost to the #55 in the first feature and even picked up two more points on the #27 with Billy's point lead still nine points on the #55 and eleven points on the #27 heading into the two-week break.

Billy and the #86 team return to Flamboro Speedway on Saturday August 17th for Meet the Drivers Night. The pit gates open at 4:00PM, the front gates at 5:00PM and racing gets underway at 6:30PM.
