

As Sauble Speedway in Sauble Beach and Sunset Speedway in Innisfil cancelled their races due to the potential heavy rain, Billy and the #86 team made their way down Highway 6 to Flamboro Speedway under sunny skies with a threat of rain later in the night. The tent supplied to the team by sponsor Hy-Grade Steel Roofing System was put up to protect the team from the sun and the #86 was ready for the first practice session. Billy took to the track for the first of two practice sessions and after setting fast time in the session, Billy was happy with handling of the car, so the team decided to skip the second practice session and get ready for the first of two 20-lap feature races.



Billy was the only Flamboro regular driver to finish on the lead lap after the previous race, so he started in the pole position on the inside of the #27 of Kevin Albers who was chasing Billy in the season long championship. The two ran side by side as the field took the green flag with the two competitors making contact before

Billy was able to pull away and take over the lead. Following Billy was the #97D of Tyler Di Venanzo who passed the #27 on the inside to move into 2nd. As the laps ticked down Billy started to pull away from the #97D as he led start to finish picking up his sixth feature win of the season followed by the #97D and the #27 rounding out the top-3.



After the car went through technical inspection, it was found that the car was very close on left side weight so the team went to work moving some lead to the right side of the car and while checking the right front to see why it was hitting the track, they found a problem with the upper control arm that was getting loose. The car was not in a position to make a repair so the bolt was tightened up and the control arm packed with grease with the hopes that it would stay together until the team had time to repair it at the shop during the week. The #31 of Kevin Gallant was slated to start the second feature on the pole but he elected to start scratch at the back of the field with the #27 of Albers inheriting the lead with Billy starting alongside on the outside



of the front row. The #27 led the field to green with Billy to his outside as again the two made contact early in the race. Despite a couple of looks on the outside, Billy was able to drop down to the inside lane behind the #27 before they completed lap 1. Billy bided his time for several laps as the top 3 pulled away from the rest of the field. Billy made his move as he got underneath the #27 heading down the back straightaway and into turn 3. Billy and the #27 battled once again as they ran side by side before Billy was able to pull away. Billy didn't look back as he led the rest of the way to bring home feature win #7 on the season. After the

first race of the night the track had decided to skip the victory lane interviews as they were worried about the incoming inclement weather. This time the fans were allowed out onto the track to take pictures with Billy and the car in victory lane to celebrate the victory.

Billy and the #86 team return to Flamboro Speedway on Saturday July 26th for a regular night of racing and the Flamboro Speedway Hall of Fame Reunion. The pit gates open at 4:00PM, the front gates at 5:00PM and racing gets underway at 6:30PM.
