




It all came down to Saturday night as Billy and the #86 team headed to Flamboro Speedway looking to bring home back-to-back pro late model track championships. The weather was warm and sunny as the team arrived at the track with the temperatures looking to start to dip in the evening as is customary towards the end of September. With a healthy lead in the points standings coming into the last night of the season, Billy and the team were looking to make a statement with just two feature races remaining.

The pro late models entered the track for the first of two practice sessions with Billy scuffing a new set of tires for season ending Grisdale Triple Crown in a couple of weeks. Billy was quite happy with the handling of the car, so the decision was made to sit out the second practice session and double check the toe which was found to be straight up instead of the usual 1/8" toe out.

The #27 of Kevin Albers started on the pole for the first of two 20-lap features with Billy starting on his outside, the #7 of Ty Cavallin starting in 3rd with a brand-new set of tires and the #31 of Kevin Gallant to his outside. The #27 of Albers got the jump early as he took the early lead. Billy tucked in behind the #27 and went to work before making his move coming out of turn 2 on lap 3 to take over the lead. Over the remainder of the race Billy put the pedal down as he put together several laps in the 15.2 second range before hitting 15.177 seconds on lap 13. That was all he needed as Billy cruised to the win with the #27 finishing in 2nd and the #7 rounding out the top 3.

No changes were required with the #7 of Cavallin starting on the pole for the second feature with the #27 of Albers to his outside, Billy on the inside of row 2 in 3rd and the #31 of Gallant to his outside. Billy took advantage of the #27 starting on the outside as he followed the #7 underneath the #27 to move into 2nd. The #7 didn't stand a chance as Billy again took over the lead coming out of turn 2 on lap 3 making his move on the inside. He would not look back as he drove away from the field to once again sweep both features and secure his second consecutive pro late model championship winning an astonishing 18 of 21 features.
